A Prayer Walk Through John 4

Day 1

Tuesday March 22

Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I will give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

John 4:14

Father God, we confess so often we drink from things other than You and miss out on Your living water that wells up to eternal life.

Wednesday, March 23

The woman said to him,
"Sir, give me this water so that I won't get thirsty
and have to keep coming here to draw water."

John 4:15

Thursday, March 24

Friday, March 25

Day 5

Saturday, March 26

Day 6

Sunday, March 27
